BY-LAW NUMBER 11-12

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE A REDUCED LOAD PERIOD ON COUNTY ROADS

WHEREAS Section 122 (7) of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, provides that the Municipal Corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway, may by By-law, designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end, and the highway or portion thereof, under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies;

AND WHEREAS the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways, under the jurisdiction of the County of Renfrew.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Renfrew hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. The provisions of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act, apply to various highways under the jurisdiction of the County of Renfrew, during the period from the first day of March to the thirty-first day of May inclusive, in each and every year. A schedule shall be made available for all restricted County Roads annually.
- 2. The provisions of Section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act shall also apply to various roads under the jurisdiction of the County of Renfrew at such other times as may be deemed necessary by the Director of Public Works and Engineering.
- 3. This By-law shall not become effective until appropriate signage has been erected, in a conspicuous place.
- 4. County of Renfrew By-law Number 12-05, passed on the 24th day of February 2005 is hereby repealed.
